

Clery Act Safety Alert
Off Campus Armed Robbery

Incident Date/Time: September 1, 2026 , at approximately 4:30PM

Incident Location: Tenth Street at 75/85S ramp

Incident Description: A male suspect approached a stopped driver and displayed a knife while on the 75/85S ramp at Tenth Street. The suspect demanded the victim's phone and withdrew money using Cash app. The suspect fled the area headed north to Fourteenth Street. There were no injuries reported. There are no threats to the campus. The victim is not affiliated with Georgia Institute of Technology.

Suspect Description: A male, wearing a dark hoodie and dark pants riding a green e-scooter. Suspect is armed with a knife.
