Off Campus Carjacking

Incident Date/Time: May 17, 2021 at approximately 1:00 pm

Incident Location: 14th Street Antiques and Modern Home -530 Fourteenth Street NW

Incident Description: The victim reported that the suspect approached her in the parking lot at 530 Fourteenth Street and pointed a handgun at her. The suspect stole the victim's vehicle and was last seen headed west on Tenth Street toward Howell Mill Road away from campus. There were no injuries reported. The victim is not affiliated with the Institute.

Description of Suspect:

Black male
Light complexion
Late teens to early 20s
5'7-5'10" tall
Dark colored hat with green stripe
Armed with a handgun
