Incident Description: A woman parked her vehicle at the gas station and went into the store while her passenger remained inside the vehicle. A Jeep Cherokee parked next to the woman's vehicle and the suspect in the Jeep reached into the woman's vehicle and grabbed her purse. The passenger tried holding on to the purse but the suspect pointed a handgun at her and demanded that she let go. The suspect vehicle was last seen headed west on 14th Street toward Howell Mill Road. There were no injuries reported. The victim is not affiliated with the Institute.

Description of Suspects:

3-4 males

One male was described as a black male wearing a camouflage hooded jacket and was armed with a handgun
