

**Clery Act Safety Alert**  
**Off Campus Person Armed/Theft by Deception**

**Incident Date/Time:** May 2, 2025, at approximately 2:40 PM

**Incident Location:** I-75/85 exit ramp and Tenth Street, NW

**Incident Description:** Officers responded to a report of a female armed with a firearm standing on the exit ramp. According to the female, 4 males selling water on the exit ramp performed a phone app theft of money from her and ran. A second victim reported the same 4 males who were selling water stole money from his phone app also. The suspects were last seen running east away from the campus. No injuries were reported.

**Suspect Descriptions:**

Suspect One: Black male, late teens, short twists in hair, tan hooded sweatshirt. black jeans and white tennis shoes

Suspect Two: Black male, late teens, black scarf on his head, black hooded sweatshirt with "True Religion" on back, gray jeans and black shoes

Suspect Three: Black male, late teens, brown knit cap, black hooded sweatshirt, and black jeans

Suspect Four: Black male, late teens, black knit cap, gray hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans and red shoes
