

Clery Act Safety Alert
Off Campus Armed Robbery

Incident Date/Time: June 8, 2025, at approximately 5:05 PM

Incident Location: North Avenue at Williams Street

Incident Description: Three males selling water at the intersection of North Avenue and Williams Street approached a vehicle stopped at the traffic light. One of the males brandished a firearm and snatched a cellphone from the driver's lap. The males fled from the area and were last seen headed south on Centennial Olympic Park Drive near Ivan Allen Jr. Boulevard. There were no injuries reported and the victim is not affiliated with the Institute.

Suspect Descriptions:

Suspect One: Black male, 15-20 years old, wearing a black hooded jacket with a colorful design on the front and sleeves, black sweatpants, white socks and sandals.

Suspect Two: Black male, 15-20 years old, wearing a white knit cap, black hooded jacket with a white design on the front and sleeves, light jeans with holes in the knees, black and white tennis shoes, armed with a handgun.

Suspect Three: Black male, 15-20 years old, wearing a black knit cap, black hooded jacket, black sweatpants, and white tennis shoes.
