

Clery Act Safety Alert
Off Campus Attempted Robbery

Incident Date/Time: November 21, 2025, at approximately 4:30 AM

Incident Location: Williams Street between Eighth Street and Abercrombie Place

Incident Description: A student reported that while walking south on Williams Street towards Abercrombie Place, a man approached her from behind and grabbed her pants pockets. She fell to the ground, and the man began searching her pockets. The man then ran north on Williams Street towards Eighth Street. There was nothing was taken from the student, and no injuries were reported.

Suspect Description: Male wearing a face mask, light blue hoodie, gray pants and black shoes
