Incident Description: A student was walking on Atlantic Drive at Home Park Avenue when two males approached from behind and demanded the student's belongings. One of the males displayed a handgun and the student dropped his belongings. The two males ran north on Atlantic Drive without taking any items. They were last seen running east on 14th Street towards West Peachtree Street. There were no injuries reported and there are no threats to the campus.

Suspect Description: Two black males, slim build, 5'5"-5'8" tall, dreadlocks, wearing black puffy jackets, black pants and blue surgical masks. One suspect was armed with a handgun.
